Total elapsed time, 90 minutes! It was still about 25% moisture, so I will have to let it sit for a week or two before I can put a finish on it. I will probably use just an oil, with a butcher block finish for the inside, which will likely see food use.

I hope those of you who took some of the honey locust are as pleased as I am with the way it has turned and finished. The plan is for the donors to take down another one next year, and I have our names in!
